



Cathedral Of The Immaculate Conception, Albany

EverGreene restored the original decorative paint scheme of this magnificent cathedral designed by Patrick Keely.

Completed in 1852, the Albany Cathedral has undergone several interior campaigns since its construction. EverGreene was requested to perform an historic finishes investigation as part of the cathedral's 20- year renewal plan. EverGreene was subsequently asked to perform the the interior restoration of the decorative finishes and statuary.

Work included the restoration of the original paint scheme, plaster repair of the existing ornament, and refinishing and glazing of the cathedral's statuary.

The restoration was completed in the fall of 2010, and rededicated with the Cardinal of New York, the Bishop of Albany, and over 1,000 onlookers.
